# Coffee Fellowship Description

**8:00 Fellowship:** When it is your turn please bring 3-4 dozen treats of some kind and place them on the new coffee counter. We have found if you bring them on a paper plate you don't have much to clean up because the goodies always seem to disappear sometime during the morning. If you notice that coffee has not been made go ahead and make 50 cups. It is not necessary to provide juice.

## **THE CHURCH PROVIDES:**

- Coffee, cups, napkins, paper cups, sugar, creamer, serving dishes and coffeepot can all be found in the drawers of the new coffee counter.

## **WHAT YOU PROVIDE:**

- Enough treats for about 120 people (store bought cookies are great!) ***Please NO chocolate brownies because they are hard on the carpeting.***
- One gallon of milk or juice, (preferably not grape juice because it stains the carpet).

## **SET UP:**

- Before worship starts, check to see if coffee is made in the fifty-cup coffeepot. This pot is usually stored right on the cupboard next to the sink. Fill the coffeepot to the fifty-cup level and add 3 cups of grounds for fifty cups. Extra coffee can be found in the drawers.
- Arrange treats on serving trays and cover.
- Pour juice into small paper cups and put out on counter.

## **CLEAN UP:**

- Wash and put away all items concerned with coffee hour, including rinsing the coffee pot.
- Dish soap can be found under the sink.
- Wipe off tables that are used.

Dishtowels should be taken home and laundered and returned by the following Sunday.
