8:00/9:00 Communion Description

BEFORE THE SERVICE:

(Set-up requires approximately 15 minutes before the service.) Communion ware is stored in the lower cabinet in the communion room. Open bottles of wine and wafers are stored in the refrigerator. Fill 1 chalice half full and put about 80 smaller wafers in pottery plate and one large wafer on top. Place the chalice and plate on the hymnal bookcase prior to the start of the worship service. Fill one tray of individual glasses with wine and white grape juice. Place it and one empty tray with the cover on the alter.

DURING THE SERVICE:

The Pastor will distribute the bread and you will hold the chalice/tray with cups. When offering the chalice/cups, say, "The blood of Christ, shed for you."

AFTER THE SERVICE:

Return the chalice/cups and the tray to the communion room, and wash them. The people setting up for the 2nd service will use them. During the summer, return the chalice and tray. Put extra-unused wafers in the refrigerator. Clean out the chalice and tray and put it all away.

10:30 Communion Description

BEFORE THE SERVICE:

(Set-up requires approximately 20 minutes before the service.) Remove communionware from the alter if left there following the 8:00 service. Take communion ware from cabinet in the communion room. Fill individual glasses with wine using the white dispenser. Wine is kept in the refrigerator along with wafers. Stack 2 filled trays and 2 empty trays and put on the altar. Fill both pottery chalices halfway. Put one pottery chalice on the hymnal bookcase. Put 100-140 wafers in both pottery bread plates. Put 1 large wafer on the altar plate. Put the other bread plate on the hymnal bookcase.

DURING THE SERVICE:

Take pottery chalice and bread plate to altar, walking behind ushers during offertory. Come back up to the front when Pastor asks for the communion assistants. The Pastor will distribute the bread and you will hold the chalice/tray with cups. When offering the chalice/cups, say, "The blood of Christ, shed for you." One of the four communion assistants should remain up front to serve communion to the Pastor and Worship Leader. When serving the bread you will say "The body of Christ, given for you."

AFTER THE SERVICE:

Wine can be poured down the sink or pour on the ground outside. Put extra wafers back in refrigerator. Wash all glasses (toss out used plastic cups) and replace in trays with clean ones. Wash both chalices and bread plates. Take towels, and dishcloths home to launder and return soon. If you have any questions concerning your role, please ask Pastor Kent or Joanne Wayne.
